Managing a large team of 180 people spread across four sister schools in two cities presents a significant challenge for all of us. I've seen photos shared by teachers, showcasing the youthful smiles and vibrant activities of our students. I've witnessed students capturing beautiful scenes with drones. This tells me that the children have succeeded; they have taken their first steps on the path of international education, stepping out of their comfort zones to experience different cultures and environments, improving their English language skills in a realworld context, and learning to face and solve problems independently, away from their parents. They will feel homesick, face discomfort, hesitate, and misbehave at times, but more importantly, they will observe, compare, think, and act. That's enough. As we approach the Mid-Autumn Festival, they will soon be returning home. Let us welcome them back with open arms!

Grade 10 has also welcomed dozens of new students who are gradually integrating into the ULC community. In addition to the upcoming Swiss MUN trip and off-campus experiential learning projects, we have secured ten spots for Grade 10 future leaders to visit and learn at St. Paul's Girls' School in the UK for two weeks. Opportunities to broaden their horizons are increasing, and we hope that students, while steadily improving academically, will actively seek and participate in both oncampus and off-campus activities, nurturing comprehensive development. Perhaps the seeds of their future professions will be planted and take root during one of these activities, shaping their lives.

External exam results release

CAIE and Edexcel exams results were released in August. In the past three years, affected by COVID 19, the exam results were much higher than those in the past. This year, everything goes back to normal. Top grades percentage decreased dramatically and some subjects A* or a percentage dropped by almost 20%. As what we expected, our students performed well in this exam season. Compared to the world statistics from CAIE, in the AS level, 77% subjects b and above percentages are much higher than those in the world. In the A2 level, 53% subjects B and above percentages exceed those in the world.

Scholarship

To encourage students to value both the learning process and the results, the scholarship policy has been updated and shared with all the students. The following students are qualified to be awarded scholarship according to the latest scholarship policy. Congratulations to all of them.

剑桥国际考试委员会(CAIE)和爱德思考试成绩在8月 份发布。受新冠疫情的影响,在过去的三年中,学生考 试成绩远高于过去。而今年,一切都回归常态。A以上 成绩的比例大幅下降,某些科目A*/A成绩的比例几乎下 降了20%。一如我们所预期的,我校学生在本次考试季 中表现出色。与CAIE的全球统计数据相比,在AS阶段, 77%科目优秀率(B及以上的成绩)高于全球水平。在 A2阶段,53%科目优秀率(B及以上的成绩)超过了全 球水平。

CAIE Exam

The Cambridge June 2023 exams have been released on August 10 for AS & A Level and on August 16 for IGCSE/O Level. All candidates have checked their results online with the confidential exam result information.

37 candidates have applied to appeal against their results across 48 subjects and 71 components.

The Cambridge November 2023 A Level/ESL retake registration is in progress. The registration process includes the start of online registration, registration and payment deadlines, students receiving a statement of entry, and information amendment deadlines. Now that the online registration deadline has passed, candidates are checking the information on their statement of entry. Students should register for the examination in accordance with the guidelines sent by the Academic Office to avoid missing the deadline.

Right now, 148 students have signed up for retakes in 14 subjects in Cambridge in November 2023. The first exam is on October 5, 2023, during the national holiday. The school arranged a series of revision lessons for those students who will take Cambridge exams in November.

Edexcel Exam

The Edexcel MJ (May & June) Math Exam results were released on August 17th and IG Art on August 24th. Students checked their results from the Result Plus account. After the result day, two students applied to appeal the result, and five students applied to view the script.

The registration for the make-up Edexcel ON (October & November) Math exam started on August 14th and ended on August 20th. 158 students registered for the make-up exam, and all of them have paid the registration fee. Students will get a statement of entry for information confirmation in September.

The make-up Edexcel ON (October & November) Math exam will start on October 9th.

Course Selection

At the beginning of the semester, the Academic Office provided instructions on how to complete the course selection on both teachers' and students' landing pages. Students are assigned math and English subjects in Grade 9 based on their performance on the admission exam. Students in G10 continue their prior coursework. During the first two weeks of the academic year, G11 students are permitted to switch optional subjects. Students in G11 typically enroll in two options, while some pick three or four. Students base their choices on academic requirements, personal interests, their ability to learn the courses, and their prior success in those disciplines.

CAIE剑桥考试

剑桥考试局已于8月10日公布了AS & A Level考试成绩, 8月16日公布了IGCSE/O Level考试成绩。学生已经通过 查询成绩的保密信息上网查询到自己的考试成绩。

37位考生向教务处提出复议考试成绩的申请,共涉及 到48个科目,71类试卷。

剑桥考试2023年11月考季A Level/ESL重考报名正在进行 中。报名节点包括:开始网上报名、报名和缴费截 止、学生收到报名信息确认表、信息修正和确认截 止。现阶段,网上报名截止日期已经过去,考生正在 查看考试信息确认表上的信息。学生应按照教务处发 出的指导信息报名参加考试,以免错过截止日期。

目前,我校共有148位同学报名参加2023年11月剑桥考 试的重考。第一场考试将在10月5日,即国庆假期间进 行。学校为参加补考的同学开设了相应的复习课程。

爱德思考试

Edexcel 5-6月考试季的数学成绩已在8月17日公布, IG 艺术成绩在8月24日公布。学生已经通过Result Plus账 号查看自己的成绩。在成绩公布后,有2个学生申请成 绩复议,5个学生申请查看试卷。

Edexcel 10-11月考试季的数学补考考试注册报名在8月 14日开始,并在8月20日结束。158名学生报名了补考 并交齐报名费。学生将会在9月份拿到考试确认单并进 行报名信息确认。

该数学补考考试将会在10月9日开始第一场考试。

课程选修

学期伊始,教务处在相关门户网站给教师和学生提供 了选课指导。根据此前在入学考试中的表现,G9年级 学生被分配到相应的数学和英语班上。G10年级学生则 继续学习此前(G9年级)的课程。开学前两周内,G11 年级学生可以更换选修科目。该年级学生通常会学习2 门选修课,而有些同学会选择3-4门。学生最终做出的

选择,通常基于学科学术要求、个 人兴趣、学习课程的能力以及此前 他们在这些学科取得的成就。

These training events included EduCare online course training, teacher professional development, and introductions and training on various school programs and initiatives such as Digital and Global Citizenship, Additional Learning Support, CIPQ, PBL and PSHE.



Every year, ULC teachers are required to complete a number of EduCare online courses. This requirement holds significant importance because these courses provide essential knowledge and skills necessary for ensuring the safety and well-being of students. During the planning week, all teachers successfully completed the course "Child Protection for International Schools." Additionally, as part of our commitment to maintaining a safe and supportive environment, we all signed the ULC Code of Practice, which is a mandatory step before working with children and young adults at ULC.

Teacher Professional Learning and Reflection (PLR) sessions are conducted regularly throughout the school year. During the planning week, Ms. Grace Liu, the PLR Coordinator, introduced both external and internal PD programs to all teaching staff. External PD opportunities include Cambridge courses and workshops. We strongly encourage all teachers, especially new teachers, to participate in at least one external PD course each year. This allows them to familiarize themselves with the updated Cambridge curriculum and enhance their teaching skills.

Regarding internal PD on campus, Ms. Grace Liu introduced the Data Wise framework and Cambridge PDQ programs. These programs are designed to cater to the diverse needs of teachers and align with ULC's mission. This year, the Data Wise program will incorporate observing practice into step 5 (Examine instruction for the Inquire group) and step 8 (Act and assess for the Act group), providing a deeper level of engagement.

Additionally, the Cambridge Professional Development Qualifications in Teaching and Learning or Educational

PLR教师专业学习和反思在整个学年定期举行。培训周中, PLR协调员Ms. Grace Liu向所有教职员工介绍了校内、外职业发展项目。校外的职业发展项目包括剑桥课程和研讨会。我们强烈鼓励所有教师,尤其是新教师,每年参加至少一门校外职业发展课程。这使教师们能够熟悉最新剑桥课程,并提高教学技能。

关于校内职业发展项目,Ms. Grace Liu介绍了DWIP数 据智慧改进过程项目的框架和剑桥PDQ教师认定资质 项目。上述项目与ULC的使命一致,旨在满足教师的多 样化需求。今年,DWIP数据智慧改进过程项目将在第 5步(审查教学指导)和第8步(行动和评估)中加入 观察实践,为教师提供较去年更深层次的参与内容。



此外,今年将继续提供教学和学习、教育领导力这两 个剑桥国际教育职业发展项目。作为中国首个获剑桥 授予 "PDQ教师认定资质(Professional Development Qualification)"的国际学校,ULC多年来一直开展基于校

Leadership will continue to be offered this year. As the first Cambridge school in China to offer PDQs, ULC has been running internal, school-based programs for our teachers for many years. These programs have successfully supported teachers in enhancing their professional thinking and practice, ultimately improving the quality of learning in our school.

Another PLR session was designed to actively involve all teachers in a discussion about the Cambridge learner and teacher attributes. Mr. Patrick Rakiro facilitated the session, encouraging us to identify the strongest and weakest attributes and guiding us in reflecting on ways to improve them. He also shared valuable ideas to enhance these attributes.

We specially held a teacher training session focused on project-based learning (PBL). The session provided a platform for the eight PBL teachers to share their project proposals with the teaching staff. Each PBL teacher presented their project, and the audience actively listened and provided valuable feedback. Following each presentation, the audience rotated to another station, where they engaged with a another PBL teacher who introduced the project specifically designed for grade 9 students. This rotation allowed for further feedback, conversations, and the exchange of ideas. It's important to note that this PBL initiative was led by our deputy principal Ms. Jennifer Li, who also facilitated the training session, ensuring a cohesive and engaging learning experience for all participants.

We also included introductions to the Digital and Global Citizenship, Additional Learning Support, CIPQ, and PSHE programs during the planning week. These programs align with our school mission - to challenge students through different programs, meanwhile developing a caring, and supportive community that equips students. Global Citizenship attributes and Digital Citizenship attributes at ULC were introduced by Curriculum lead Ms. Ruth Cumberland, and teachers had reflections on how to incorporate these attributes into daily teaching. The PSHE is a school subject through which students develop the knowledge, skills and attributes they need to manage their lives, now and in the future. 我们特地举办了一次聚焦PBL项目式学习的教师培 训。该会议为8名校内PBL教师提供了一个平台,与 教职工们分享他们的项目式学习方案。每一名PBL教 师都介绍了他们负责的项目,场下作为观众的其它 教师则积极倾听,并给出宝贵的反馈。听完一场项 目介绍后,观众又前往另一个项目介绍点,由这个 环节的PBL老师介绍专为G9年级学生设计的项目,随 后展开新的交流。这种"周游列国"的交流方式激 发了教师间更深层次的反馈、对话和思想交流。这 次培训,给所有参与老师带来了一次关于新项目的 高参与度学习体验。该场培训会议由副校长Ms. Jennifer Li主持,她同时也是学校PBL项目式学习的倡导 者。

After School Activity (ASA)

We are delighted to offer students the opportunity to extend their learning through engaging after-school activities. Our afterschool activities aim to create a sense of belonging, improve social skills, provide academic support, and make learning fun. A goal of our ASAs is to motivate students of all backgrounds to discover new strengths and practice new skills to inspire a global community of future scholars and leaders. College Acceptance



The arrival of the new academic year ushered in the confirmation of the final acceptance of our class of 2023 graduates and the beginning of a new chapter in their life.

Currently, according to the data, 50% of the 18th graduating class of ULC chose to attend British universities, of which 44.3% will enroll in one of the UK's G5 super-elite institutions. In contrast, 13.1% of graduates attended institutions in the United States and Canada, 13.1% attended institutions in Hong Kong China and Macau China, and 23% attended institutions in Australia. Overall, 78.68% of this year's graduates were successful in getting into one of the TOP 50 universities in the QS World University Rankings. Information about the final destination has been updated on the school's official website (<u>https://</u> <u>www.ulinkcollege.com/en/support/university acceptance.html?</u> <u>year=2023</u>), which parents can see independently.

College Application

After the release of the A/AS Level results, the CAIE Results Analysis and University Application Preparation Meeting for Year 12 students and parents was conducted on September 1. Our Class of 2023 has begun the university application season. We intend to assist students in evaluating and reviewing their CAIE results, provide advice on university applications and creating a timeline for their applications through this analysis session. Currently, CAS Advisors have assisted the G12 students in filling out all of the registration and online application forms in a timely manner on both the UCAS in the United Kingdom and the Common Application in the United States. The CAS Office highly advises students to remain involved, contact with their advisors, and submit their applications in early given that Chinese applicants make up the largest percentage of non-EU applicants and have placed first for ten consecutive years. The deadline for on-campus applications is October 13 for Oxbridge applicants and November 15 for other regular UK applications, although this time is earlier than the official deadline of UCAS: a. 16 October 2023 18:00 UK time (University of Oxford, University of Cambridge and most medical, dental, veterinary majors close); b. 31 January 2024 18:00 UK time (most undergraduate course close). We strongly advise students to submit their applications in advance as places are limited. However, if students need to retake most of the A Level subjects, it is recommended to submit the application after retaking the exams. The specific submission date should be discussed with their assigned CAS advisors.

大学录取

大学申请

现阶段,G12年级同学已进入大学申请季。A Level成绩 公布后,面向G12年级学生跟家长的CAIE成绩分析及大 学申请准备会也已于9月1日举行。通过本次分析会, 我们希望帮助学生评估检视其CAIE成绩,提供大学申 请指引及规划申请时间线。目前升学指导老师们已提 前有序指导同学们完成了英国网申系统UCAS,美国通用 申请平台Common Application所有的注册及网申填写。 考虑到中国申请者在非欧盟申请者中占比最高, 且连 续十年蝉联第一, 升学指导办公室强烈建议同学们保 持积极主动跟升学老师沟通,提前完成申请递交,我 们设定的校内申请截止时间分别为:牛剑申请为10月 13日, 其它常规英国申请为11月15日。尽管上述时间 点提前于UCAS的官方截止时间: a. 英国时间2023年10 月16日18:00 (牛津大学、剑桥大学以及大部分医学、 牙医、兽医学等专业申请截止); b. 英国时间2024年1 月31日18:00(大多数本科课程申请截止),但由于名 额有限, 我们强烈呼吁学生提前完成申请。但如果学 生需要重考多门学科,可以在重考之后再提交申请, 具体提交时间请跟升学老师讨论后确定。

College Visits



In September, the CAS team has already arranged one-on -one portfolio reviews with admissions officers from the University of the Arts London and Maryland College of Art, as well as school visits from Loughborough University, the University of Sheffield, the University of Exeter, and the University of Westminster. University representatives visiting our school encourage students to think critically and prepare them for future study options while also allowing them to explore career paths and major options. They also provide students with first-hand information about university admissions both domestically and abroad. The CAS team works to guarantee that all students, regardless of grade level, have equal chance to access prestigious universities around the globe and understand the importance of preparing for college. Notice of Subsequent University Visits: We consider it a great honour to host world-renowned universities like the University of St. Andrews, Durham University, Lancaster University, University of Nottingham, University of York, McGill University, University of Waterloo, and University of California during the end of September and the months of October and November. The resources available at the school should be fully utilised by students as they learn and develop within. After taking in the vast and enormous, students nurture intensely in their own studies.

CAS Events

This year, the CAS event will continue to be held on Thursdays from 3:30-4:30 p.m., featuring alumni sharing, career talks, and university visits. On September 14, the students in grades 10-11 were invited to participate in a career talk by Philippa Yang, a ULC alumna and special guest who works for Amazon.com in the ESG industry (Environmental Social and Governance). In addition to drawing on her experience, she will impart to younger pupils the invaluable wisdom she gained along the road and assist them more effectively as they move through the high school, college, and employment phases. Moreover, students will have the chance to broaden their horizons, comprehend the varied innovation of science and technology practise projects, and observe how peers deepen their understanding of knowledge in practise when the leader of Tencent's Mini Goose Series Innovation Training Project visits ULC on 19 October.

The new school year is coming! How to form healthy relationships and better communication with your kids.

1. Build awareness about your own emotions which can hugely affect a child's emotions and behaviors. Realize your own emotions from work and life, how do those pressures come at home? Teenagers are very sensitive to other's emotions towards them. Be objective about your opinions towards your child. Be careful about your negative words or expressions, which can be detrimental to your child's confidence. Be genuine about your own emotion and make it reasonable for your child to understand.

2. How to deal with conflicts. Conflicts are common in every family, please do not be afraid of conflict or only communicate through conflicts. Do not over-interpret your child. It is easy to have conflict with teenagers who always have extreme emotional ups and downs. Being calm and relaxed rather than angry can solve conflicts easier. When you feel angry, you might try to give yourself a 10-second "buffer period" -- try to use 10 seconds first to calm yourself down during the "buffer period". Be more understandable and acceptable to your child's small mistakes and be serious about fundamental mistakes.

3. Set boundaries of making mistakes and know how to

ALLOW. Parents can discuss with their children to set the corresponding rules and boundaries of making mistakes. Please note that it does not mean that children are not allowed to make mistakes. And please note that there should be no verbal shaming of children at any time. Parents should also know how to ALLOW. You should allow your child to have his or her right of "private life", such as the right to have fun and make friends, to keep his or her secrets, and to arrange his or her time. In this process, parents should know how to provide timely guidance according to the actual situations but also know how to negotiate and reconcile with their children.

新学期开始了,家长需要怎么样和孩子建立健康良好 的沟通与关系呢?

 具有明确的自我情感感知力。能清晰分辨自身情绪 波动和为何某种情绪会占领自己的身体。注意自己有 没有把工作上的情绪带到家庭气氛中。青少年对亲密 关系中的情绪感知力非常敏感,并且容易自责和过度 解读。因此,对待青春期孩子的情绪输出尽可能做到 中立、客观。如果在必要的批评情况下,评判语句表 述必须针对事件,而不是孩子。对孩子不要有任何隐 瞒,现在青少年的认知能力普遍早熟,真诚是沟通的 关键。

2. 如何应对争端。争端在每个家庭都很常见,不要惧 怕争端或者喜爱争端。因为青少年正在构建自身的价 值与自尊,对于意见有很强的倾向性,不要过度解读 你的孩子。在遇到让你愤怒的事情时,不妨试试给自 己10秒的"缓冲期"——先试试数10个数,让自己在 "缓冲期"内平复情绪。对于孩子无关紧要的错误多 包容,少挑剔,对于原则道德性时,要及时发现并且 与孩子进行有效沟通。

3.与孩子共同建立起双方认可的家庭规则、奖罚机制。家长与孩子商讨什么事情是绝对禁止的,设置好相应的规则与犯错误的界限。请注意,这不代表不允许孩子犯错,而且任何时候都不要对孩子进行言语上的羞辱。懂得禁止,也要懂得许可。家长要许可孩子拥有自己"私生活"的权利,如娱乐交友的权利、保留秘密的权利、安排时间的权利。在许可的过程中,家长要懂得根据实际情况及时地引导,更要懂得如何与孩子协商、和解。
